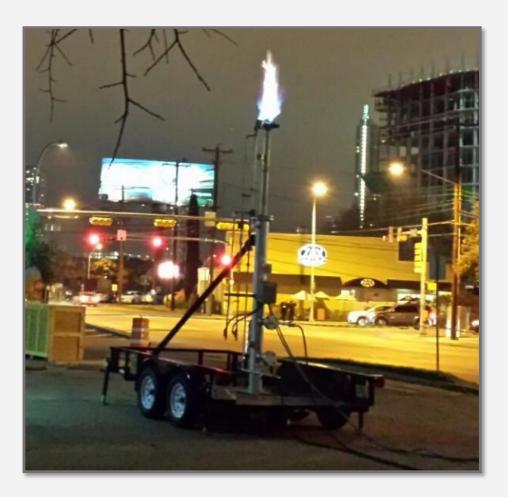

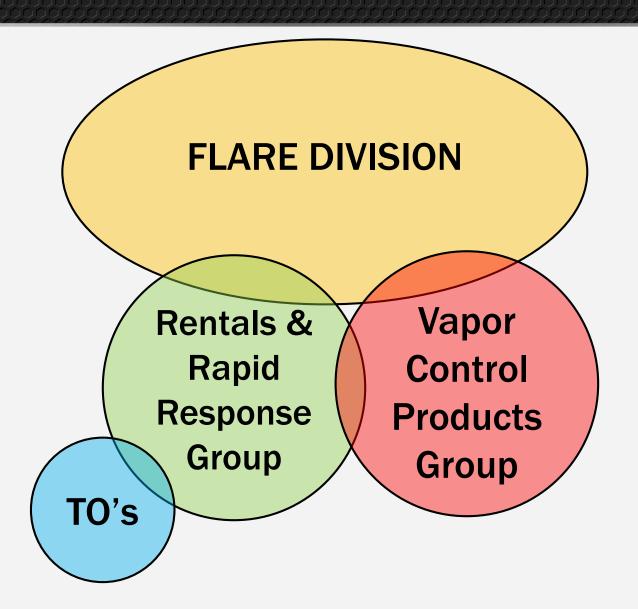

What We Do

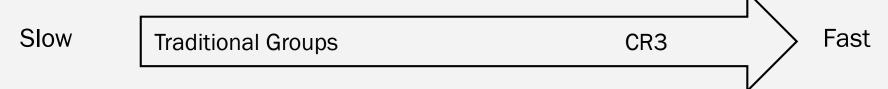


- Provide custom engineered solutions at a price point and delivery comparable to that of standardized equipment

- These packages are available for short or long term lease, lease to own and outright purchase.

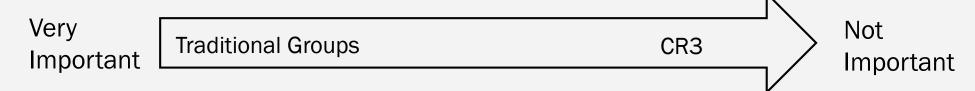

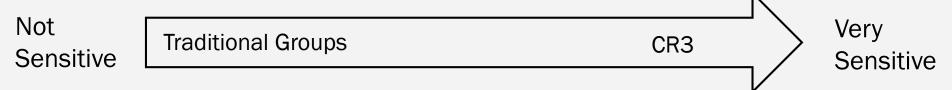
> How quick is the customer's need?

- Continually Grow the Design Base to Address Additional Applications







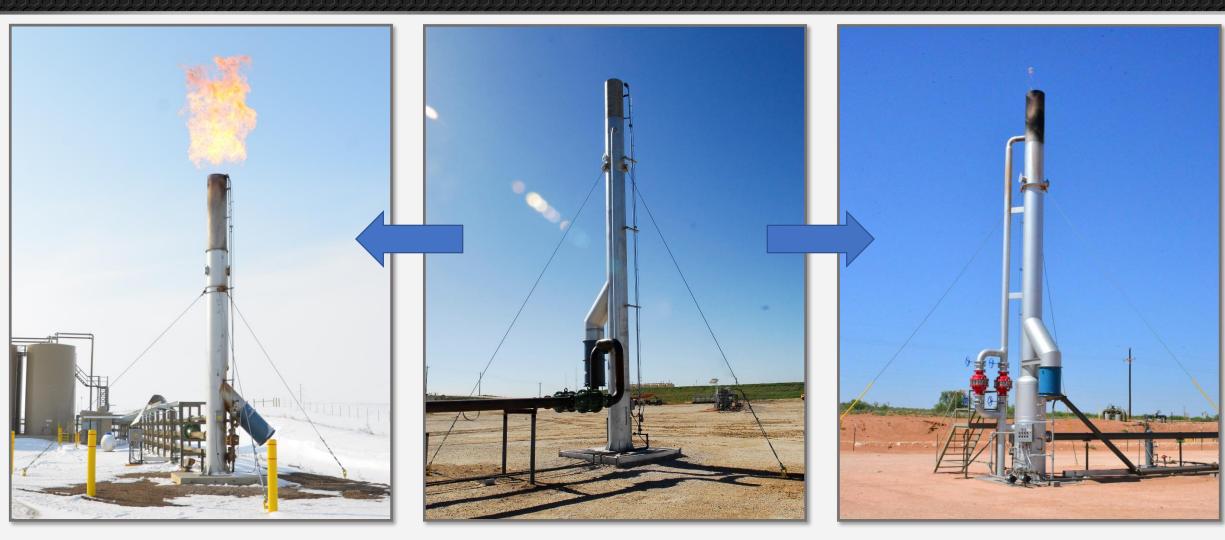

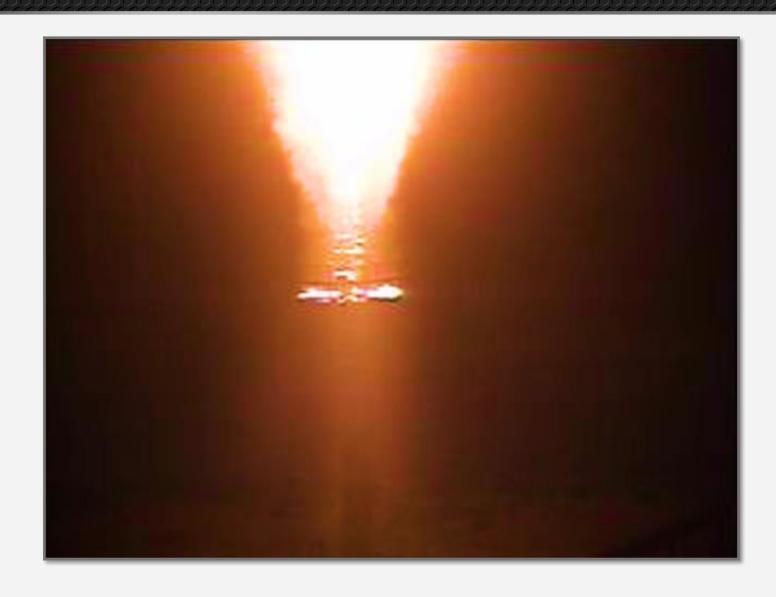

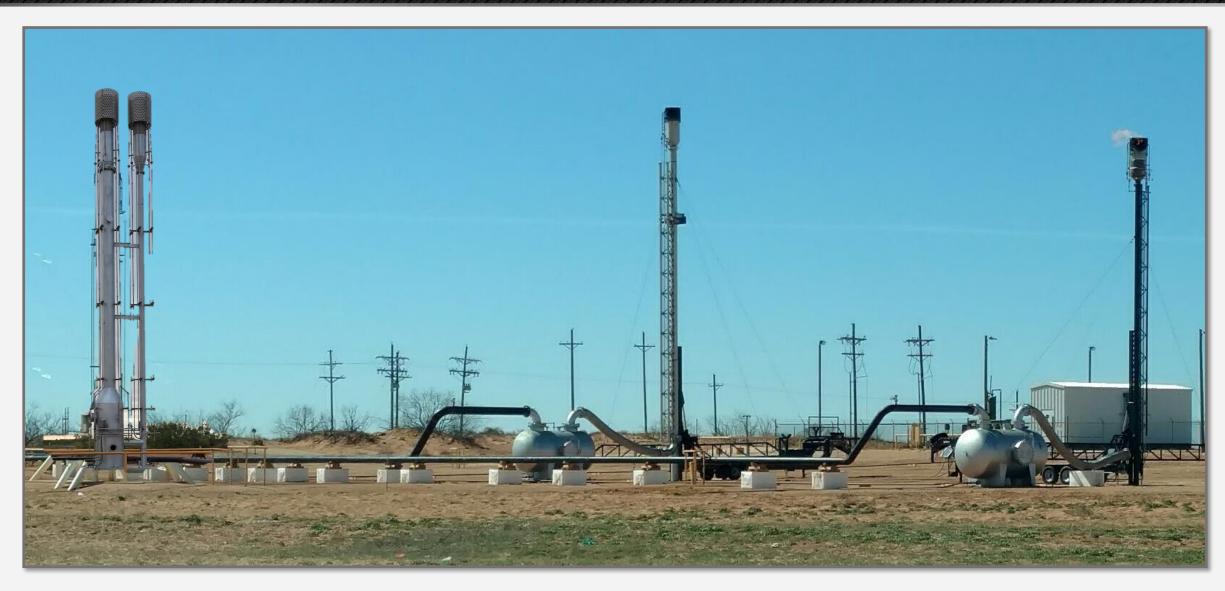

- >300 feet tall
- > 50+ inch diameter
- Capacity: 0 to 3 MM lb/hr
- > Steam, air and non assisted
- Multiple installation and supporting methods
- Open and Enclosed Flame
